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Interaction with Batch of 2019

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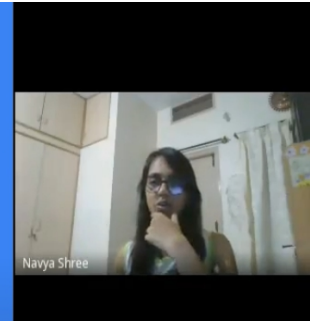
## Event Summary:

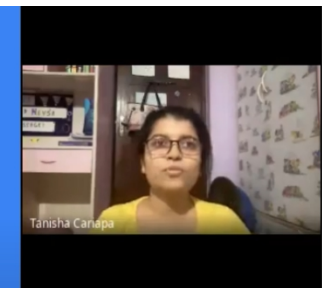
Some of the highlights of the alumni meet is summarized below:

- It was interesting to observe that the alumni suggested that one need to attend classes, and should not attempt to miss the classes.
- They also shared that the strictness of the department has helped them all in their professional career
