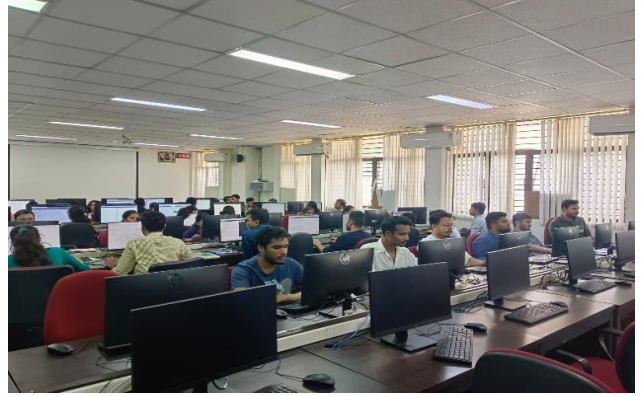

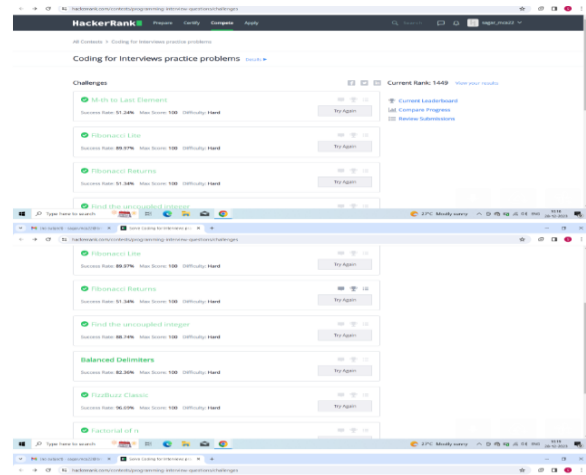

January 11, 2024: Placement Club, Department of Computer Applications organized an activity mainly focused on enhancing teambuilding and soft skills capabilities of the students.

January 25, 2024: Placement Club, Department of Computer Applications organized a debate session for third semester MCA students to uplift their communication skills. A team of two was created and were given a topic. Both the team members had to speak for 4 mins for and against the given technical and non-technical topic.



Febraury 1, 2024: Placement Club of Department of Computer Applications organized an interactive session to have a discussion about the difficulties faced during the interview and other challenges during the coding round.



Febraury 8, 2024: Placement Club of Department of Computer Applications conducted debate and mock interview sessions. This activity was conducted in order to overcome the challenges faced in interviews and improve public speaking skills. The interview panel was consisting of two people with multiple rounds which includes technical and HR round.

Febraury 29, 2024: Placement Club of Department of Computer Applications organizes a session on debate. A team of four students were given a particular topic- two students about pros and 2 for cons. An equal opportunity was given to all the first semester MCA students.





March 7, 2024: A guest talk on "Leadership training and Communication skills" was organized by Placement Club, Department of Computer Applications for first semester MCA students. Resource person for this event was Ajay P, Thynke Services Private Ltd, Bangalore. This event was coordinated by Mr. P Lakshminarayana, Mr. M Siva Rama Krishna and Mr. R V Raghavendra Rao.



March 21, 2024: Placement Club, Department of Computer Applications hosted a public speaking event for MCA, Section A students. Each team of five students was assigned a topic to talk about.



After discussion with every team member, group had given sufficient time to talk on the topic in front of the class.



March 21, 2024: Placement Club, Department of Computer Applications organized a resume writing session for first semester (sec-B) students, emphasizing its importance in the shortlisting process. We started with an introduction to resumes, highlighting their role in showcasing skills and experience to potential employers. We provided guidance on the essential elements to include and what to avoid in a resume. Additionally, we offered a simple resume layout for students

to follow as they crafted their resumes. This activity aimed to help students recognize their skills and strengths, preparing them for future job applications.



April 4, 2024: Placement club, Department of Computer Applications, organized a press panel where teams were supposed to give presentation on the given scenario. Here, the accused team taken the role of defending themselves in a media setting, while the other team acted as the victim, asking probing questions. Participants were also allowed to ask questions to both the teams.



April 13, 2024: Preplacement training program was held for first semester MCA students. During this, trainer provided valuable insights on dressing appropriately for interviews to leave a positive impression, while also highlighting the importance of body language in effective communication. Furthermore, the session covered the art of crafting well-structured emails, catering to both formal and informal contexts. The final session focused on revisiting fundamental mathematical concepts, aiming to enhance problem-solving abilities.



April 14, 2024: Placement training activity was conducted by Universal Education for first semester MCA(Sec A) students. The program focused on resume building skills, covering essential aspects like formatting, content, and presentation. Additionally, there were sessions dedicated to problem-solving in number systems, helping participants strengthen their analytical and mathematical abilities. These sessions aim to equip attendees with practical skills for job applications and technical assessments.





April 14, 2024: Placement training activity was conducted by Universal Education for first semester MCA(Sec B) students. The initial session was led by Mr. Ahinshu Ghosh, emphasized numerical aptitude covering topics such as Time and Work and Number Systems. The subsequent session, facilitated by Ms. Snehal Parithar, a seasoned soft skill trainer with a decade of experience, focused on professional resume writing. It was a highly beneficial session where participants gained essential skills crucial for placement interviews.
