Course on Kannada is further divided as Basic kannada and Advanced kannada. Basic kannada was a program started as an initiative by the department of electronics and telecommunication engineering. 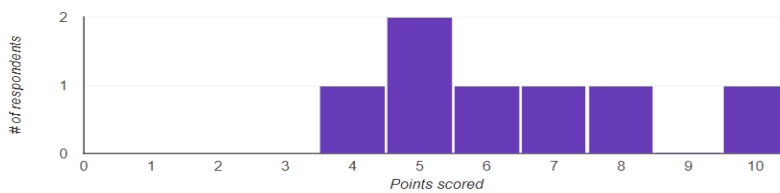
