The Chairman, BOG, extended a cordial welcome to all the Members & invitees to the meeting.

The Member-Secretary informed the Board that for the first time in the history of BMS that the Board has taken important step of inviting Student representatives for the meeting. This initiative clearly indicates the commitment of the BOG towards transparency & development. While on the subject, the member secretary also apprised the Board that the minutes of the 52nd meeting are published on the college website. While expressing satisfaction over the new initiative, the BOG welcomed Student representatives on Board.



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The Member-Secretary introduced the Board Members to the student representatives. The faculty invitees and the students introduced themselves and they thanked the BOG for inviting them. The Board desired to know any suggestions or grievances for the academic development of the College.

The student representative from MBA expressed the campus placement opportunities for the MBA students are inadequate. The Chairman assured that he would discuss the matter with the concerned officers & faculty. Further he stated that the institution would make all necessary arrangements to provide more opportunities for placement of MBA students.

The student representative of Information Science highlighted the non-availability of text books of latest version in the library. The Chairman assured that necessary arrangements will be made to procure in consultation with the concerned officials.

In general all the students expressed that it was their dream to pursue higher education at BMSCE. They are happy with the institution & the opportunities provided for learning.

The Board thanked the student representatives for their suggestions and informed to come prepare with more points next time for the academic development of the College.

Section 1: ITEMS FOR CONFIRMATION

1.1 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 52ND BOG MEETING HELD ON 15TH JULY 2013

The Member-Secretary apprised the Board that the minutes of the previous (15.07.2013) BOG meeting has been published on the College Website.

The minutes of the 52nd Meeting of the BOG held on 15th July 2013 were confirmed.



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Section 2: ACTION TAKEN REPORT

2.1 ACTION TAKEN NOTE ON THE DECISIONS/RESOLUTIONS TAKEN IN THE 52ND BOG MEETING HELD ON JULY 15, 2013

The BOG noted the Action Taken Report of the 52nd meeting of BOG held on July 15, 2013 and approved the following:

Sub No.4.1 of 52 – DRAFT GUIDELINES FOR EVALUATING THE ANNUAL ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE OF THE FACULTY.

The Member-Secretary appraised the BOG that as per the directions of the Board, the guidelines/duties & responsibilities for evaluating the Annual Academic Performance of the faculty has been brought to the notice of all the faculty members and only one comment received with regard to weightage given to authoring a technical paper. After detailed deliberations, the Board made it clear that it is a practice being followed by the academic institutions and hence the Board approved the guidelines/duties & responsibilities of the faculty members for evaluating their Annual Academic Performance. This comes into force with immediate effect.

The Member-Secretary also apprised the Board that the Annual Performance Monitoring Committee (APMC) has also drafted the guidelines in respect of various designators. After detailed deliberations the Board approved the guidelines/duties & responsibilities (enclosed at *Annexure-I*). The guidelines/duties & responsibilities come into force with immediate effect.

Sub No.4.6 of 52 - CONSIDERATION OF THE POLICY FRAMED WITH REGARD TO POOR PERFORMANCE RATED THROUGH STUDENT FEEDBACK.

The Member-Secretary apprised the Board that the resolution of the BOG with regard to poor performance rated through student feedback has been informed to all the faculty members vide Circular No.BMS/PPL/PS/13-14 dated 12.08.2013. However, the decision of the Board to implement the said decision to the current faculty members who have low feedbacks derived out of various feedback processes carried out so far could not be implemented due to busy with other activities. The Member-Secretary assured that the same will be implemented in due course and will be placed in the next meeting.

Section 4: ITEMS FOR APPROVAL

4.1 INTRODUCTION OF NEW POST-GRADUATE PROGRAMMES & ENHANCEMENT OF INTAKE OF EXISTING UG COURSES

The Principal & Member-Secretary apprised the Board that a note was submitted to the Council of Trustees, BMSET regarding the need for starting of new PG programmes in VLSI Design and Embedded Systems and Manufacturing Science & Engineering; and Enhancement of intake in existing Undergraduate Programs in Architecture (from 80 to 120) & Mechanical Engineering (from 120 to 180). The Board noted that the Council of Trustees has accorded approval for the same from the academic year 2014-15. The Board considered the matter. After detailed discussions, the Board approved starting of new PG Programmes and also enhancement of intake in the existing UG Programmes as detailed below:

New PG Programmes (Under Unaided/Management Category):

M.Tech in VLSI Design & Embedded Systems with an intake of 24;
M.Tech in Manufacturing Science & Engineering with an intake of 24

Variation in intake in existing UG Programmes (Under Unaided/Management Category):

B.E. in Mechanical Engineering - From existing 120 to 180;
B.Arch. in Architecture - From existing 80 to 120

The Board also authorized the Principal to initiate appropriate action to commence the new programmes & obtaining approval for enhancing intake for the concerned authorities (VTU, State Government & AICTE); further the Board authorized Principal to put-up proposal for the necessary infrastructure & human resource required in this regard with the approval of the Chairman, BOG.



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4.2 RESIGNATION LETTER BY Dr.BISWARUP SAIKIA, ASSISTANT PROFESSOR, DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL ENGINEERING.

The Board took note of the resignation tendered by Dr.Biswarup Saikia, Assistant Professor, department of Civil Engineering on 25.06.2013 working against the sanctioned post under Grant-in-Aid since 09.04.2007. The Board also took note that he has obtained relieving order after payment of one month's salary in lieu of one month's notice period as per KCSR.

The Board approved & ratified the same.

Section 5: ITEMS FOR RATIFICATION

5.1 GRANT OF TIME BOUND PROMOTIONS TO NON-TEACHING STAFF WORKING UNDER GRANT-IN-AID

The Board noted the Government's initiative in further extending the Time Bound Promotions (presently the same is extended who has put in 10/15/20 years of service) to the employees who has put in 25/30 years of service (as the case may be) in the same cadre/post held by them without any promotion throughout their service and having satisfactory performance record vide its GO No.ED 71 DTE 2013 dated 06.07.2013

5.2 RE-DESIGNATION OF POST AS PER REVISED AICTE SCALE OF PAY.

The Board noted the clause that the existing position of Lecturer has been re-designated as Assistant Professor in the 2006 Revised AICTE Scales of Pay and 2006 Cadre & Recruitment Rules. The faculty appointed as Assistant Professor through Direct Recruitment and the existing faculty members in the scale of Selection Grade and who have completed 3 years in pre-revised pay scale of Rs.12000-18300 on 01.01.2006 shall be placed in Pay Band of Rs.37400-67000 with AGP of Rs.9,000/- and shall be re-designated as Associate Professor

Principal

The Principal shall provide leadership for the academic administration and create an effective environment conducive for learning. He shall ensure that quality education is imparted to the students and fosters the holistic development of the students. He shall ensure all round development of the Institute and achievement of strategic goals of the institution.

1. The Principal shall Report to the Chairman, BOG on all matters.
2. The Principal is the Head of the Institution and shall act as a link between the Staff, Students and Management.
3. In the capacity of the Member-Secretary of the Board of Governors, he shall put-forth proposals in all administrative/academic/finance related matters and seek approval and ensure its apt implementation.
4. The Principal shall assess the HR requirement and make recruitments as per the procedures and norms.
5. Ex-officio Chairman of the Academic Council of the College-shall advice and guide the Chairpersons of the BOS for providing curriculum to match with market needs; ensure implementation of the decision/regulations approved by the Council.
6. The Principal shall act as a link between external agencies and the Institutional faculties.
7. The Principal shall facilitate all the stakeholders to provide the necessary impetus for growth and development of the Institution.
8. The Principal shall ensure that proper administrative and evaluation process in addition to addressing to the rightful grievances of the students, staff and faculty members.
9. The Principal shall from time to time prepare Strategic Plan for the Institution which sets the milestones to be achieved.
10. The Principal shall be the executive in-charge of all academic and administrative bodies and ensure adherence of all regulations framed by the Board of Governors (BOG).
11. Conduct regular meetings among various bodies as necessary, for proper functioning of the Institution.
12. Comply in a timely fashion all records and reports required by the various agencies like UGC, AICTE, DTE, VTU, TEQIP and others.

Dean-First Year (B.E.) Students

The Prime Role of Dean (First Year B.E.) is to liaise between the administration and first year students. The responsibilities are as follows:

1. To guide the students regarding Rules and regulations
2. To co-ordinate with various trainers/counselors towards providing additional training needs.
3. To monitor the class list of the students and administer changes as required with the approval of the Principal or Vice-Principal
4. To monitor the student attendance. Authorized to condone the attendance as prescribed.
5. To monitor the conduction of Classes in co-ordination with the concerned HODs.
6. To suggest methods of improving the first year curriculum.
7. Interact with the HOD/Proctors/faculty members handling first year courses to resolve student related issues.
8. Ensure that the CIE (both attendance and marks) are recorded/maintained properly by the concerned faculty. To liaise with the Controller of Examination in this regard.
9. To ensure proper conduct of CIE (Tests, Quizzes etc)
10. To identify slow learners and arrange for remedial coaching on need basis by seeking due approval.
11. To ensure students are free from any acts of ragging or other such activities.
12. To focus on learning aspects of foreign students and provide necessary academic support in co-ordination with ICD.
13. Any other responsibilities in this regard assigned by the Principal from time to time.

Head of the Department

The prime role of the Head of an Academic Department is to provide strong academic leadership.

1. The Head of Department is required to lead, manage and develop the department to ensure it achieves the highest possible standards of excellence in all its activities.
2. Responsible for ensuring the educational progress and welfare of students registered with the Department
3. To plan and prepare proposals for development of the department.
4. Involve self and the other faculty in the process of curriculum development, in updating and revision on continued basis to meet the requirement of industry.
5. To organize the academic work load of the Department (theory classes, drawing classes, laboratory classes, Project supervision etc) as per norms indicated by Principal/BOG/other statutory bodies.
6. To supervise the attendance of students in classes and laboratories and to scrutinize the academic progress of students.
