

following guidelines has been approved by the Chairperson, BOG pending ratification by BOG. He further apprised that Adjunct faculty shall be eminent professional/scientist/engineer/professor of practice/industry experts. He also apprised that the guidance/tutoring by experts in the field of industry, research and specific academic fields would facilitate in improving the employability of our students.

During deliberation, the Board noted that the University Grants Commission (UGC) has also recommended to appoint Professor of Practice to enable the institution to focus on Skill-based education, integrating vocational education with general education and strengthening industry-academia collaborations with focus on National Education Policy 2020. The Board further noted that appointment of Adjunct faculty also plays an important role in the assessment by NBA/NAAC/VTU and other assessing agencies.

The Board noted the guidelines towards appointing an Adjunct Faculty as mentioned below:

- (i) <u>Qualification and Experience</u>: An Adjunct Faculty shall be a person of eminence, from reputed Teaching/Industry/Research organization with or without a Post Graduate or Ph.D. qualification, having 10 to 15 years of experience. The upper age limit for Adjunct Faculty shall be 65 Years.
- (ii) The Adjunct faculty member shall visit the institute for a minimum of 50-60 hours per semester.
- (iii) The Adjunct faculty is expected to teach course(s) directly related to his/her specific expertise and professional experience and shall also contribute to the activities viz., participating in departmental committees, serve as advisors to faculty or UG and PG students and also help in networking and collaboration with industry/organisations for providing internship and job opportunities for students.
- (iv) An honorarium payable shall be Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) per lecture of one hour upto a maximum of Rs.4,000/- (Rupees four Thousand only) per day of service, subject to a maximum ceiling of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand only) per month.

(v) The performance of Adjunct Faculty shall be monitored through a Committee constituted for the purpose based on the Self-Assessment Report and recommendations by the concerned Head of the Department. 


