MINUTES OF THE FIFTH MEETING OF THE SUB COMMITTEE OF BOARD OF GOVERNORS (BOG) FOR TEQIP PHASE II HELD ON 20<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2013 AT 4 PM IN THE BOARD ROOM OF THE COLLEGE.

The Principal and the convenor of the sub-committee of BOG welcomed the members for the meeting.

**1. To confirm the minutes of sub-committee meeting held on 29.1.13.**

The minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the BOG sub-committee held on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2013 were perused and confirmed [**Annexure-1**].

**2. Appointment of MIS data entry operator at TEQIP Office**

The committee noted the NPIU mail dated 5.2.2013 informing the institution to have a MIS cell equipped with adequate full time staff i.e., at least 2, one MIS officer and the other MIS data entry operator and pay the salary from out of TEQIP-II funds.



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The committee further noted that Smt. P. V. Padmini qualified with B.Com degree and GNIIT course at NIIT and possessed an experience of one half years in related work. A test was conducted by Dr. K. R. Radhika, Professor-ISE and Webmaster of BMSCE on 27.02.13 and was found suitable for appointing her as MIS Data entry operator. She was appointed as MIS Data entry operator at the TEQIP Office as per the Official Memorandum dated 01.03.2013 on a consolidated salary of Rs.10,000/- and P.F. thereon per month, with due approval of the Chairman-BOG. The committee approved the appointment of Smt. P. V. Padmini as MIS Data Entry Operator(Annexure-2). The committee authorized the Principal to find a suitable person for appointing as MIS officer.

**3. Encouragement to R & D and Institutional Consultancy Activities**

The committee perused the PIP (Project Implementation Plan) published by the NPIU providing the details pertaining to permissible and non-permissible expenditures under TEQIP-II activities. The committee after detailed deliberations approved the following activities & expenditure during the TEQIP-II period:

**a) Publication of research papers in peer reviewed journals:**

Reimburse the bills pertaining to expenditure made by a faculty up to a maximum of Rs.10,000/- per paper towards preparation & publication of the research paper in peer reviewed national & international journals with a **minimum impact factor of one.**

**b) Expenditure on consumables for those registered for PhD:**

Reimburse the bills towards procurement of Consumables or preparation of drawings, testing the samples etc., to a maximum extent of Rs.50,000/- for a research scholar pursuing PhD in one of the research centers of the college, as and when the expenditure is incurred with due certification by the guide limiting Rs.10,000/-, Rs.20,000/- and Rs.20,000/- during their first, second and third year of the program respectively.

**c) Expenditure made towards printing & binding of Ph.D. thesis and publication of the content of the thesis:**

Reimburse the bills for expenses towards PhD thesis printing & binding charges and publication of Thesis-based research papers in per reviewed journals up to a maximum of Rs.25,000/-.



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**d) Expenditure towards receiving guidance of external expert/consultant for preparing research projects for submission to external agencies for sanction of grants**

Faculties are permitted to receive guidance from external expert/consultant for preparing research projects and pay an honorarium/ consultation fee of Rs.3, 000/- per sitting, in addition to the actual expenditure made towards travel & hospitality.

**e) Commercialization & patenting of research products.**

Reimburse the bills towards the actual expenditure made on commercialization & patenting of research products including the consultant (recognized by the college) fee.

**4. Encouragement to develop research interest among UG & PG students**

The committee approved the reimbursement of bills towards their expenditure on consumables, materials, material testing etc., needed for the R&D projects based on the recommendations of a committee consisting of at least three faculty members under the chairmanship of the HOD/Senior Professor of the department nominated by the HOD of the concerned department as below:

- a) Pay fiscal incentive up to a maximum of Rs.10,000/- for an industry oriented and/or innovative R&D project by UG students (maximum of four in a group).
- b) Reimburse the bills up to a maximum of Rs. 20,000/- for an in-house R&D project by a PG student.
- c) Reimburse the travel cost (road/rail) of those students who associate with an industry for about 3-4 weeks during vacation to continue work on R&D projects of the college.

The committee authorized the Principal to relax the above ceiling on the financial assistance in exceptional cases, based on the recommendations.

**5. Faculty Qualification up-gradation as Planned through TNA**

The committee approved the reimbursement of the course fee paid by the faculty members towards their registration to PhD program on full time/part time in the research centers of the college or in any other recognized institution in the country.

**6. Subject knowledge and research competence up-gradation of faculty from Engineering disciplines and supporting departments as planned through TNA & Training of Technical support staff**

**(a) Registration fee:**

It is accepted to reimburse the registration fee **and** the Principal is authorized to sanction advance towards payment of registration fee based on the request by the concerned faculty/staff member.



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**(b) TA/DA to faculty & staff towards attending conferences/workshops/training/development programs etc.**

The committee approved the reimbursement of the bills pertaining to TA, boarding & lodging expenses to faculty members attending workshop/ conferences /training etc., as per MHRD/NPIU norms on production of travel tickets, boarding & lodging & food bills. In the event of a faculty/staff member fails to submit boarding, lodging or food bills, it is resolved to pay DA as per the KCSR norms.

**(c) TA/DA to faculty & staff towards attending workshops/training/ meeting etc., arranged by NPIU/SPFU**

TA, Boarding & Lodging/DA to the faculty members/officials for attending training programmes, workshop, meetings etc., arranged by NPIU/SPFU to be paid as per actual expenses as per the prevailing norms.

**7. Hospitality and honorarium:**

After detailed deliberations, the committee accorded approval for payment of honorarium & hospitality as below:

- (a) The honorarium to consultants, academic & professional practitioners for participation in R&D, for delivering Expert lectures and to industry personnel for participation in curriculum development/revision, for organizing and administering Continuing Education Programs etc., to an extent of Rs.2,000/- per lecture of one hour duration/per sitting/per consultation.
- (b) Sitting fee for BOG members be paid @ Rs.3,000/- per meeting from TEQIP as per NPIU norms.
- (c) Hospitality charges on account of delivering expert lectures/for meetings regarding curriculum development to be paid as per actual but limited to Rs.3,000/- per session.
- (d) Hospitality charges for BOG meetings or any other meetings held at the institution levels and for campus interviews to be paid as per actual.
- (e) Honorarium to faculty members for remedial classes may be paid at the rate of Rs.750/- per hour. The faculty for remedial classes should be identified by the concerned HOD and preferably be assigned to regular/contract faculty members with good feedback from students and pass percentage of not less than 80% in the courses handled by the faculty. Honorarium to Class IV employee be paid Rs.150/- per day who assists for the conduction of remedial classes.

The committee authorized the Principal to decide about the hospitality, sundry expenses and honorarium regarding any activity not covered above and also authorized to initiate/conduct the activities under TEQIP and incur the permissible expenditure as per the norms specified in PIP document.



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**8. Review of status of Procurement:**

The committee noted the status of procurement process and approved the proposed changes in the mode of procurement, change in the earlier approved items, variations in the cost of the certain items where the quotations were called (Annexure-3). Further, the committee asked the nodal officer for procurement to initiate the procurement under NCB's following the procedures already set in.

**9. Any other items with the permission of the Chairman:**

- (a) The committee noted the contents of the expenditure statement submitted to SPFU by the college till 28<sup>th</sup> February 2013 (Annexure-4).
- (b) The committee ascertained and noted the approvals given to the TEQIP Co-ordinator with reference to conduction of workshops, attending conference & training program by the faculty and staff for the period Jan-March 2013(Annexure-5).
- (c) The committee approved the list of in-house faculty & staff training/development plan for 2013-14 to be submitted to SPFU (Annexure-6).
- (d) The committee approved the annual training/development plan of faculty & staff for 2013-14 to be submitted SPFU (Annexure-7)
- (e) The committee approved the Annual expenditure plan for the financial year 2013-14 to be submitted to NPIU/SPFU (Annexure-8)

**2: Status of Procurement**

The committee reviewed the constitution of Departmental Procurement Committees by the various departments and approved the same [Annexure-2]. The members were informed that the procurement process through PMSS would be initiated from 1.2.2013.

**3: Award of Teaching Assistantships to full time Non-Gate M. Tech. students**

The committee took note of the exercise done towards the award of teaching & research assistantships. After detailed deliberations, the committee approved the following procedure for finalizing the selection of candidates for the award of Teaching & Research Assistantships

1. The available number of teaching assistantships has to be distributed equally for all the existing eligible PG programs as far as possible.
2. Following shall be the percentage of allocation of teaching assistantships among various categories of students rounded to the nearest integer.

Sl.No.	Category of students	% of allocation
1.	SC	15
2.	ST	7
3.	OBC	28
4.	GENERAL	50

3. To have uniformity, selection of candidates shall be based on their PG CET rank only.
4. After allotting the teaching assistantships to SC category candidates, the number of teaching assistantships remaining in that category shall be transferred to ST category. After allotting the teaching assistantships for ST category candidates, the number of teaching assistantships remaining in that category shall be transferred to OBC category. After completion of allocation to SC/ST/OBC categories, the remaining number of teaching assistantships shall be transferred to General category.



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With reference to the proposal of the academic nodal officer seeking approval of the committee for considering the left over candidates of SC/ST/OBC under General category based on their merit, the committee opined that teaching assistantships remaining in one category can be adjusted to the next category as mentioned above but the candidates have to be considered only under the respective category to which they belong failing which, the allocation to the general category cannot be maintained as 50% as per the norms. Hence, the committee resolved not to transfer the names of the candidates belonging to other categories to the General category.

The members noted the communication from SPFU dated 19.1.13 which states that “the Teaching/Research Assistantships can be given to both 1<sup>st</sup> year & 2<sup>nd</sup> year students who have been admitted on or after the date of signing of MOU between the Institution and the Government of Karnataka for the academic year 2012-13”.

The members further noted that the current second year M. Tech. students have completed their third semester examinations and will only be doing their project work and hence opined that awarding teaching assistantship to them is not justifiable. The committee scrutinized 44 applications received from the students of I semester M. Tech. and found that one of the applicants namely, Mr. Ravi Teja of Machine Design has passed GATE exam and hence, will not be eligible to be considered under Non-Gate category. The committee noted the details of the eligible applications received and allocation of teaching assistantships to be made for various categories as below:

The committee made the selection of candidates for the award of 30 teaching assistantships as per the above distribution and the approved list of the selected candidates is enclosed [Annexure-3]. The committee noted that the academic year 2012-13 has commenced from 19.10.12 and approved the award of teaching assistantships to the selected 30 candidates w. e. f. 1.11.12 instead of the earlier approved date i.e., 1.1.2013.

**4: Award of Teaching Assistantships to students of full time M.Sc.[Engg] by research**

After going through the communications received from NPIU & SPFU with reference to the award of assistantships, the members expressed that PhD & M.Sc. [Engg] by research, both are research programs and there is a need to encourage scholars pursuing both the programs as TEQIP-II emphasizes for encouraging research attitude in the campus. The members informed that the concerned shall pursue the matter with the competent authorities of VTU/AICTE and seek clarification with reference to awarding teaching assistantship for full time students pursuing M.Sc. [Engg.] by research. The committee agreed to consider the award of assistantship to these after getting further clarification.

**5: Award of Research Assistantships to full time research scholars**

The committee noted that as per the MOU signed by the institutions on 24.7.2011, the project became effective on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2010. Added to this, the members noted the MHRD communication dated 22.1.13 stating that “Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme [TEQIP-II] has been started during Financial Year 2010. However, it has been seen that progress is unsatisfactory as of now”. After deliberations,

- (a) The members opined that the actual research work by the scholars enrolled to Ph. D starts during their second year of the program or after their comprehensive viva and hence approved the award of research assistantship to the scholars pursuing Ph. D in their II/III year during the academic year 2012-13.
- (b) The committee further approved the award of research assistantship to the scholars who got their initial registration converted to full-time from part-time Ph.D. Programme.
- (c) While discussing the award of research assistantship to a Ph.D. scholar in Bio Technology Department with qualification of MSc, the committee expressed that the candidate has registered for PhD in Engineering department and the registration was accepted by VTU as per norms and hence eligible for award of research assistantship.

After a scrutiny and detailed deliberations, the committee approved the sanction of Research Assistantships to the 6 applicants, as per the list enclosed [Annexure-4] with effect from 1.1.2013.

**6: Any other items:**

The Principal informed the members that three proposals for establishing the Centre of Excellence under TEQIP-II as mentioned below were submitted to NPIU.

1. Centre for Advanced Materials Research
2. Centre for Technologies for affordable Healthcare
3. Centre for Energy generation, Analysis and Management



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
