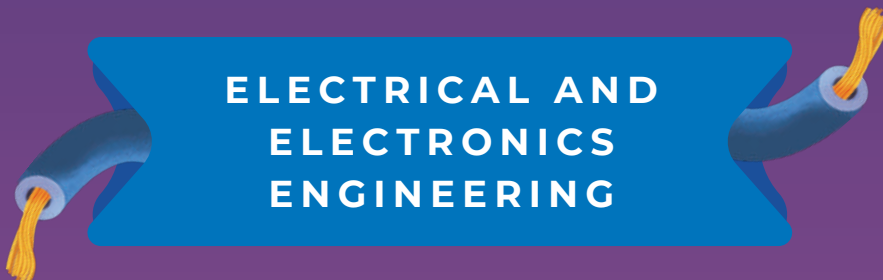

## LIKITHA YALLEGOWDA

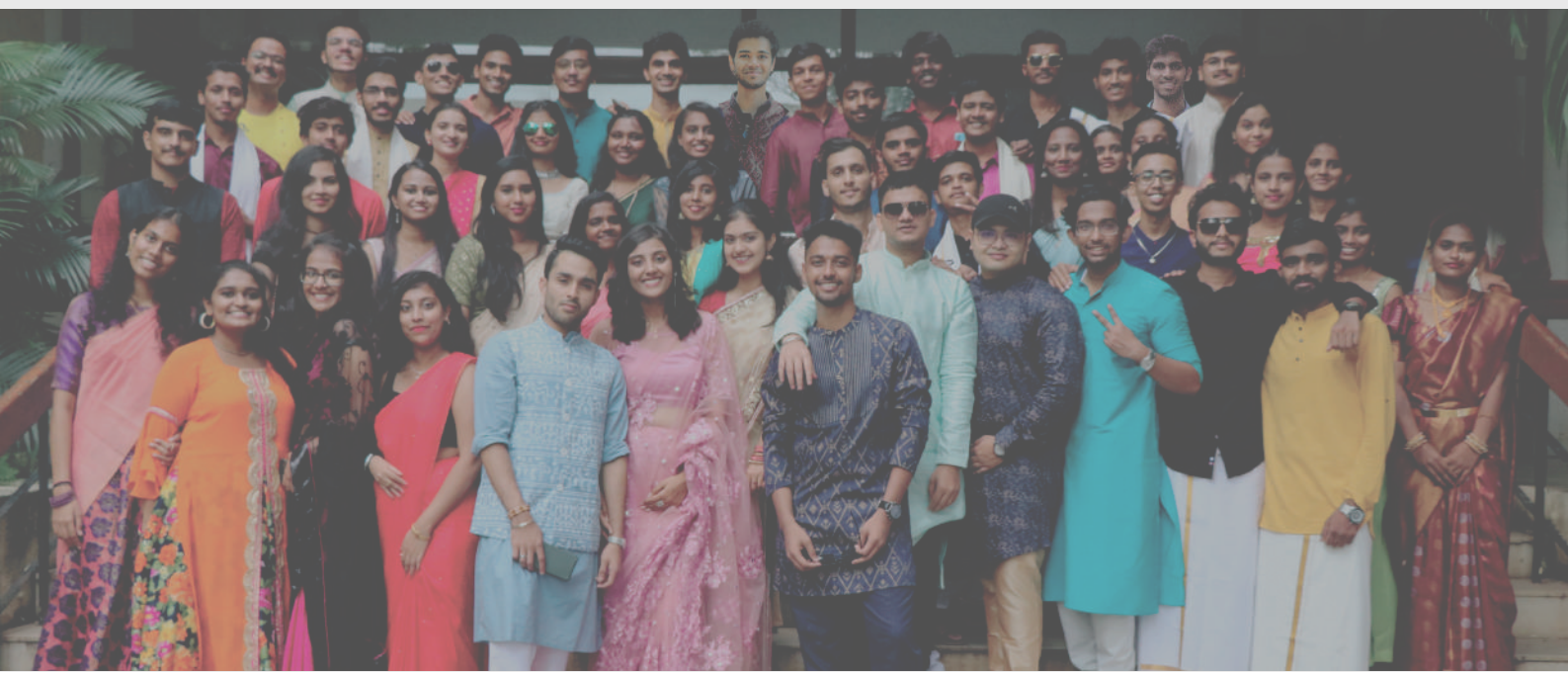
